The weather in the Azores Islands is changeable, however the Azorean people are blessed with a mild weather throughout the year.

During the winter, strong winds stir the sea and purify the air. The average temperature remains at a generous 14° C, which do not prevent snow from falling on the summit of the mountain of Pico, given its altitude (2,351m). The rainy periods, although frequent, are generally short. The summer is warm and sunny, with temperatures staying around 24° C. The sea water remains at an inviting temperature, between 17° C and 23° C.
